對不少在美華人來說，學英文是一種生活需要，在工作和生活上能夠與人溝通，融入美國的社會。到了入籍更是一個重要目標，因為成為美國公民後，可以申請家人來美團聚；到退休時，也可享有政府的保障。因此，我們開辦英文班，在服事他們的時候，並把福音傳給他們。

我們從2000年十月開設拼音班，又在2005年二月增設入籍班及會話班，先後開辦了十九期拼音班、四期入籍班、及五期會話班，分別以國語或粵語教授，接觸超過600位朋友。每次上課均有傳福音時間，藉著宣講福音，或欣賞見證影帶，幫助他們認識主耶穌基督，不少朋友因此蒙恩得救。

English Classes

Many Chinese immigrants recognize the importance of learning English in order to communicate and assimilate into American society. Becoming naturalized citizens is the first step towards petitioning for additional family members to come to the States. Retirees who have a grasp of English often enjoy more benefits. The Gospel Center's English classes allow us to demonstrate God's love by meeting practical needs.

We began offering phonics classes in October 2000. In February 2005, we introduced citizenship preparation and conversational speaking classes. In all, we have held 19 phonics classes, four citizenship preparation classes, and five conversational speaking classes. These classes taught both in Mandarin and Cantonese were attended by over 600 people. Each class included a time where we shared about Jesus Christ through Gospel messages and testimonial videos. By God's grace, many have come to place their hope in our Lord Jesus.
